- Step 2 ..........Make a Table of Contents and list the specific core at the top (ex. Core 1 Table of contents) Alphabetize the terms listed that you don't know
- Step 3......Answer the terms you don't know alphabetically matching your table of contents in the direct order listed in your notebook directly from training or from <a href="https://www.Support.Office.com">www.Support.Office.com</a> Please number <a href="https://www.Support.office.com">ALL</a> your pages and Table of Contents
